FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is AHA?

As an U.S. State Department-designated sponsor, AHA is authorized to issue the Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) Status (form DS-2019) to participants. Form DS-2019 is the necessary document to support an application for an exchange visitor visa (J-1 visa). AHA is the premier provider of international training and exchange programs specifically designed for the hospitality industry. For more than 30 years, AHA has helped thousands of people gain the knowledge and skills necessary to live and work in a globally interdependent and culturally diverse world. AHA offers the most comprehensive, relevant, and valuable exchange programs available.

Am I Eligible?

Trainee candidates must:

- ◆ 18 years of age or older
- ◆ Proficient in English
- ◆ Has either a degree or professional certificate from a foreign ministerially-recognized post-secondary academic institution and at least one year of hospitality work experience, acquired outside the United States; or five years of work experience in the hospitality industry acquired outside the United States.

What types of positions are available?

There's never been a better time to do a training program in the United States! AHA offers full placement service at four and five star hotels and resorts to include Marriott, Hilton, Sheraton, Hyatt and luxury independent resorts throughout the United States. Our approved hotels offer positions focusing in Food & Beverage and Culinary operations, limited Front Office opportunities also available.

How long can I stay in the USA?

The maximum duration of the Hospitality J-1 Internship and Training program is 12 months. At the end of your program, you will have a grace period of 30 days to travel in the USA.

How much will I get paid?

Compensation depends on the property and the position. On average, you will receive \$9 - 10 an hour. AHA's host properties assist with housing.
